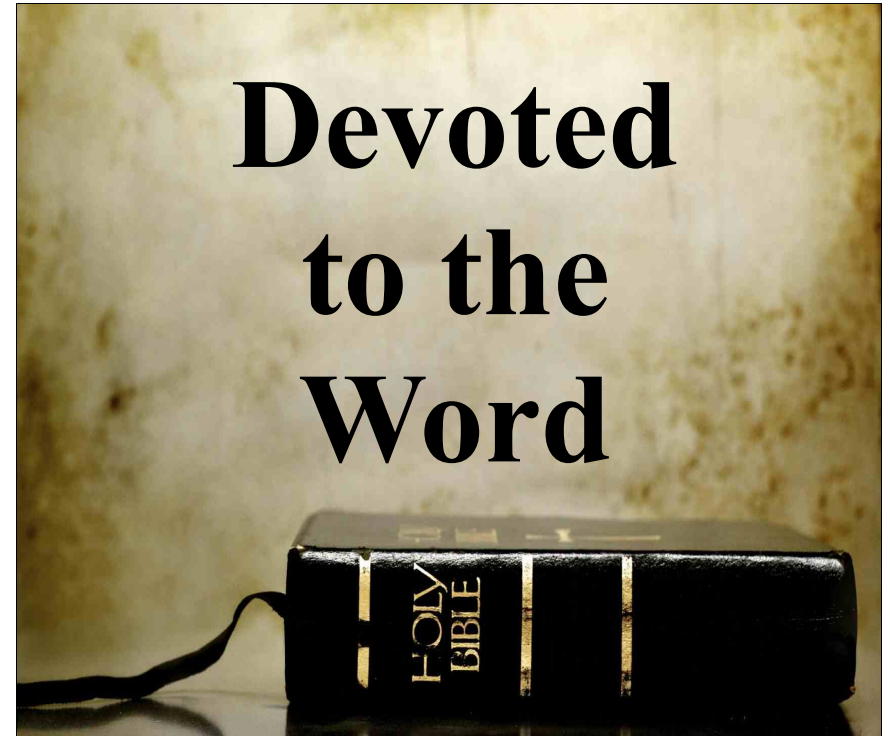

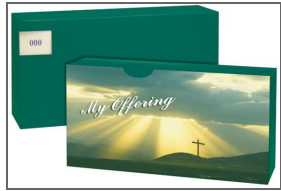

Reading the Bible Out loud

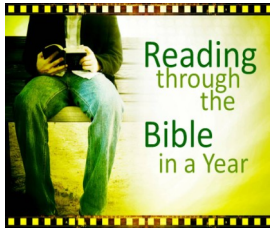

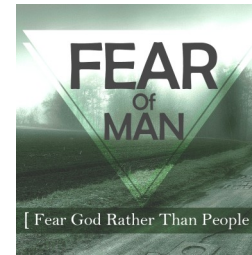
Audio/Visual Ministry

Family Worship Service

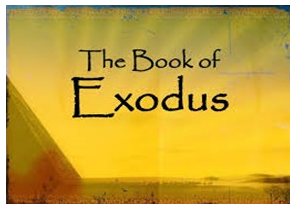

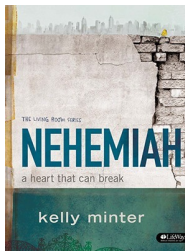
FREE Meals on Tuesday 5:30-6:30pm

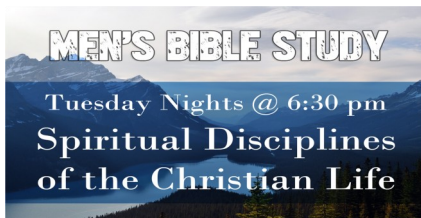
Adult Bible
