TODAY'S TEXT: MATTHEW 13:10-17 WITH PASTOR BEN WETHERINGTON

Evangelism Training—Starting Sunday, August 24th at 6:00pm

Most Christians want to share their faith but don't out of fear—fear of not knowing enough, offending others, or being rejected or ridiculed. This multiple session study will teach you a natural, non threatening way to share the gospel that reduces the pressure, arguments, and fear of failure. You'll learn how to use simple questions in the course of everyday conversations to lead someone to faith in Christ. You'll also learn how to let the Bible provide the answers to someone's spiritual need as the Holy Spirit convicts and convinces the person through the power of God's Word. Just like thousands of others who've learned this approach to evangelism, you too can experience the joy of sharing Jesus without fear.

This training will replace the Sunday Evening Service for 5-6 weeks and will be held in the classrooms down the Educational wing. Pastor Adam will provide the Children (Pre School–5th Grades) with an Evangelism Training of their own.
